



WORKS NOTIFICATION

TOORAK ROAD WEST SEWER WORKS - ROAD CLOSURE UPDATE 20 FEBRUARY - LATE APRIL 2017

Works in preparation for major construction of the Metro Tunnel are continuing in the Domain Precinct with the gas service relocation works now underway on Toorak Road West.

Further to our works notification dated 16 January 2017, we will be commencing installation of the new sewer on the residential side of Toorak Road West, between St Kilda Road and Leopold Street.

What we are doing

- Using a surface-launched drilling rig to bore beneath the road and install the new sewer
- Temporarily closing a number of local streets at Toorak Road West concurrently, which will shorten the duration of the works
- These temporary access closures are unavoidable due to the location of the new sewer manholes in Toorak Road West.

What to be aware of

- These works (known as 'preparatory works') have been granted the relevant planning approvals to proceed
- Traffic management measures will manage the safety of work crews, pedestrians and cyclists
- There will be periods of medium to high levels of noise associated with the works. These will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs) to ensure community disruption is minimised

- A site compound will be established in the centre median car parks near the corner of St Kilda Road and Toorak Road West occupying approximately nine car parks for the duration of the works
- Temporary occupation of kerbside car parking within the direct vicinity of works
- Continuing gas works on the Fawkner Park side of Toorak Road West resulting in occupation of kerbside parking and single flow of traffic in each direction around these works.

When

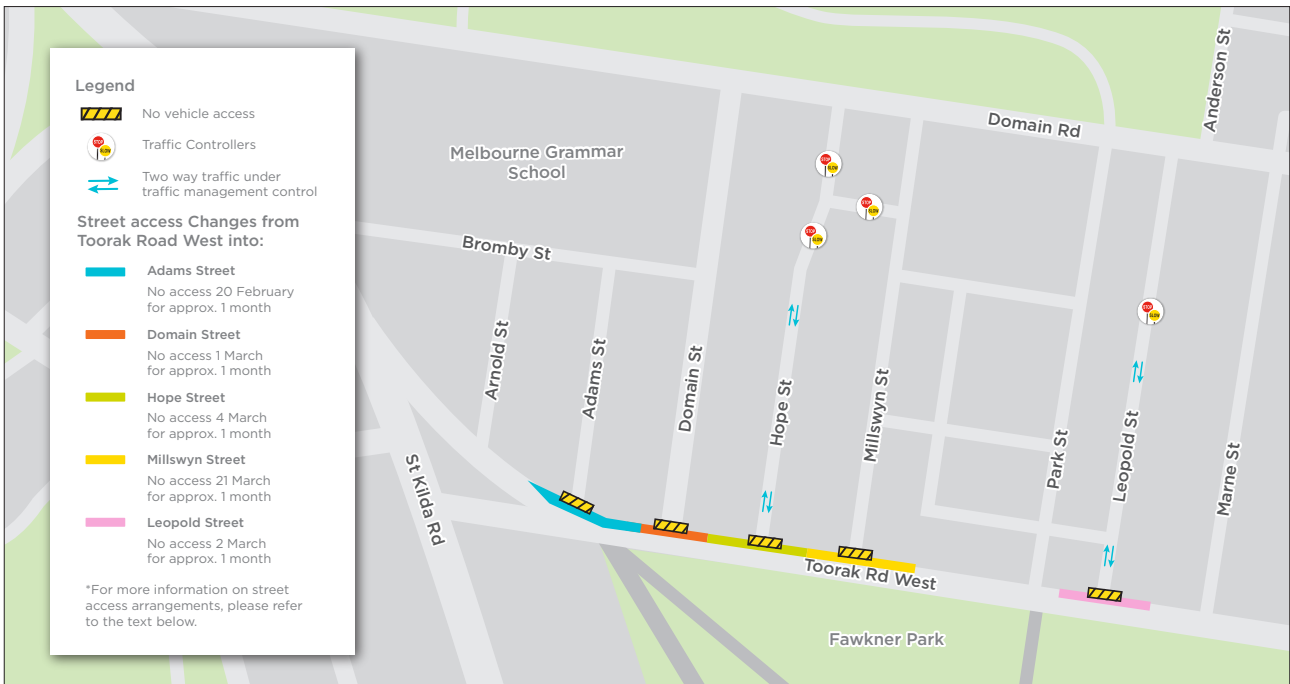
- 7am-6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am-1pm, Saturdays
- At the completion of these works there will be an additional 2 day closure required at each street in April to connect properties to the new sewer and remove the temporary diversion. Information will be provided ahead of these subsequent closures.

Street access changes for vehicles

Adams Street - from 20 February

- Adams Street will not be accessible from Toorak Road West for approximately 1 month

Domain Street - from 1 March

- Domain Street will not be accessible from Toorak Road West for approximately 1 month

Leopold Street - from 2 March

- Leopold Street will not be accessible from Toorak Road West for approximately 1 month
- Local access in and out of Leopold Street from Domain Road will be maintained using traffic controllers during working hours
- Outside of work hours, metal plates will be installed over the worksite to provide access out of Leopold Street into Toorak Road West.

Hope Street - from 4 March

- Hope Street will not be accessible from Toorak Road West for approximately 1 month
- Local access in and out of Hope Street from Domain Road will be maintained using traffic controllers during working hours
- Outside of work hours, metal plates will be installed over the worksite to provide access out of Hope Street into Toorak Road West.

Millswyn Street - from 21 March

- Millswyn Street will not be accessible from Toorak Road West for approximately 1 month

The indicative timing of these street closures is subject to change due to weather, ground conditions and other impacts to our program identified during our works. Where significant changes to our program occur we will notify community members directly impacted by these changes.
