



WORKS NOTIFICATION

WATER MAIN DIVERSION AND SOUTH YARRA MAIN SEWER WORKS UPDATE, ALBERT ROAD, SOUTH MELBOURNE **3 APRIL 2017 - NOVEMBER 2017**

Works in preparation for major construction are continuing in the Domain precinct with the water main in Albert Road, South Melbourne required to be diverted.

The water main works are 'enabling works' and have been granted the relevant planning approvals to proceed.

From 3 April to 8 April, a combination of day and night works will be required to divert the water main.

These works are required to be done prior to the relocation of the South Yarra Main Sewer beneath the future Domain Station.

The relocation of the South Yarra Main Sewer will not commence until early works approvals are in place.

What we are doing

Water main diversion

- Open cut trenching on two sections of the southern leg of Albert Road during day works. This involves saw cutting the road pavement and excavating the trench to the required depth.
- Installing and testing the new water main during night works.
- Reinstating the road during day works.

What to be aware of

- Water service disruption notices will be issued to affected properties by the water retailer in advance of the disruptions
- Impacts from noise, dust and vibration will be managed in accordance with the Metro Tunnel's Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs) with high level noise activities to be prioritised as day works
- Excavation of the trench across Albert Road will be done in two stages with staged lane closures in place to minimise traffic impacts
- Traffic management and detours will be in place around works, with no impact to footpaths
- Approximately 5-10 car parking spaces will be occupied as part of this work
- The work area will be reinstated at the conclusion of works.

- Monday 3 April, Tuesday 4 April and Friday 7 April 2017, 7am - 6pm
- Saturday 8 April 2017, 7am-1pm

Night works

- Wednesday 5 April - Thursday 6 April 2017
- 6pm - 7am

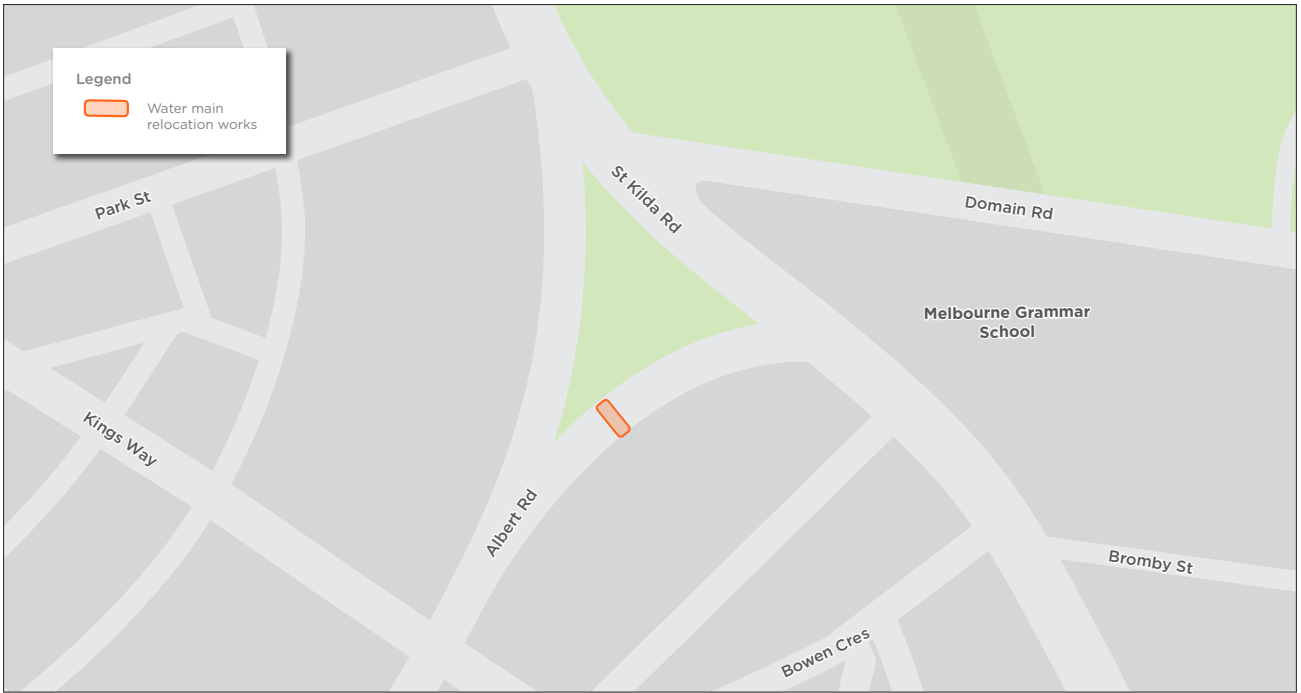

Subject to the approval by the Minister for Planning of the Managing Contractor's Early Works Plan, John Holland will commence early works in the area including the relocation of the South Yarra Main Sewer.

These works will require the closure of the southern leg of Albert Road between April and November 2017, sewer shaft construction, the removal of two small trees and temporary changes to traffic.
