



WORKS NOTIFICATION

OVERNIGHT ST KILDA ROAD CLOSURES DOMAIN PRECINCT 17 SEPTEMBER 2018

As previously notified in the Domain Precinct September Construction Update night works are required to undertake traffic barrier adjustments on St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road West.

What we are doing

To undertake works to adjust traffic barriers we will need to close St Kilda Road at the following locations from Monday 17 September for up to three nights:

- Southbound – from Dorcas Street to Toorak Road West
- Northbound – from Toorak Road West to Albert Road

These works are expected to generate intermittent periods of medium to high level noise associated with the movement of concrete traffic barriers. Works will involve the use of a small crane to shift barriers, light towers, generators, hammer drills, line marking vehicles, water blasting and line marking.

When

- 8.30pm - 5.30am
- Monday 17 September for up to three nights.

Traffic and Pedestrian changes

St Kilda Road traffic will be diverted via Kings Way. Access to residential apartments and businesses will be maintained via Kings Way (see map). Please pay attention to traffic signage in the area and allow extra time for your journey.

These works need to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are low. There will be no disruption to tram services.

There will be periods of medium to high level noise associated with these works.
